Since Hurricane Matthew "wobbled" near

Palm Beach last September, the Board has been reviewing our hurricane preparedness process and gathering quotes for various readiness options. The biggest challenge for a self-managed building such as ours is relying the abilities, willingness and availability of owners present at the time preparation is required. It is a BIG job to prepare for a hurricane—lots of heavy work for the building, as well as personal preparation prior to evacuating. Although we were well prepared thanks to our ground crew at the time, we were saved from a direct hit by the last minute change in direction. The latest assessment for protective screens helps to protect our building in future storms. Please refer to the letter sent to owners for details.

It's turtle season (Mar 1 to Oct 31) with nesting well underway. Be sure to block light coming from your unit. (Click for regulations.)

Recent Maintenance Activities

Around the inside

- Mirror trim was replaced in the main entrance/ north lobby and new mirror trim was installed between the elevator doors
- Painting was completed in the billiard room and on the card room doors
- A louvered egress door was added to the billiard room
- Routine annual maintenance service was performed on hot water heaters
- LED lights and fixtures were added to the bike room and locker storage areas
- Vents were installed in the bike room door to improve overall air circulation in that area
- New kitchen cabinets, countertops and appliances were installed in rental Unit 100

Around the outside

- The building sewer lines were cleaned out
- A new roof access door was installed to replace the door damaged by high winds
- Painting was completed on the roof staircase and west entrance walkways

 The roof staircase was also welded to complete repairs due to deterioration

- Roof repairs due to water damage were done
- A new gate arm replaced the previous damaged arm at the road entrance
- Several walkway ceiling light fixtures and exit signs were replaced
- The red bollard lights along the walkway were replaced with amber lights. Both colors are turtle-friendly but amber improved illumination
- The water access plumbing lines adjacent to the grill were repaired due to damage caused by recent high winds

New brakes were installed on the pool cover frame castors

Around the exercise room

A new thermometer was added to the sauna

Preparedness & paperwork

- A revised and updated version of the "Building Operating Systems and Emergency Procedures" book was completed in March
- The Documents and Records committee purged outdated and duplicate files and developed a directory to facilitate access to the files while maximizing storage space

Hurricane Preparedness is EVERYONE'S Responsibility

As we approach hurricane season, June 1 to Nov. 30, we must remind all owners of *their* responsibility to ensure their condos are securely protected. This requires making sure all hurricane shutters are functional and closed securely whenever the owner is not onsite. During Hurricane Mathew preparations, it was noted that some unoccupied units had not completely secured their units. This leaves not only that individual unit

susceptible to water and wind damage but other units as well.

The following recommendations will protect all our units and building:

NOW:

Make sure your shutters are functional and able to be closed completely by whoever is there at the time. This means all tracks for shutters should be in place to ensure closure. To facilitate closure, make sure to lubricate shutters at least every 6 months to keep them working. If repairs are needed, call a shutter company or person to fix prior to hurricane season.

DURING A HURRICANE WARNING:

- All shutters must be closed and securely latched so they will not separate with wind.
- Clear elevator lobbies on your floor of all items. They may become airborne in a hurricane.
- Bring in all plants, vases or other items outside your units on common walkways as they will become projectiles.

Please be a good neighbor and do your part to keep our building safe and secure.

Remember, the board is not responsible to secure your unit. They,

along with owners and renters present, will be busy storing common outdoor furniture and equipment, securing common areas and possibly preparing to evacuate! Please plan ahead and do NOT rely on the residents for assistance.

readily available, especially during hurricane season and for issues like water main breaks, as recently occurred in April.

Reminder to owners and renters that in the spring, birds come into the northern shuttered balconies through the water spouts or water drains to make their nest. To avoid this messy problem, it is necessary to either place a piece wire mesh or a large plastic bottle in the hole that allows for water drainage and impedes bird access.
