# Summer 2015 Wrap Up

Hurricane Season—With the official hurricane season for the Atlantic coast being from May 1 to November 30, the 2015 season has ended. This season saw 11 named storms with the majority under a category 3. None made landfall in Florida so the season had no impact on south Florida. The last 10 years have been mild in Florida since the last major storm in 2005, when *Wilma* came in from the west coast of Florida, crossed the state, and went out through Jupiter.

**Turtle Season**—From March 1- October 31 turtle season rules the beach. Now that the nests have hatched, lighting and beach raking can resume.

#### Baseball Stadium Coming to WPB —

Palm Beach Co. approved the building of a \$144 million stadium hoping to bring the *Houston Astros* and *Washington Nationals* to West Palm Beach for spring training in 2017. The stadium, along with training facilities and a new city park, are to be built on 160 acres at the southeast corner of 45th St. and Hayerhill Rd.

Vista Blue, our new neighbor north of the Hilton, has broken ground with few buyers so far. It is expected to be completed in 2017.



**SOS! Whale in trouble**. On Oct 8, a pygmy whale was spotted struggling in the water off Singer Island. Biologists took it to the Harbor Branch Oceanographic Institute in Ft. Pierce to be checked out.

A later article reported that it was actually a melonheaded whale. The whale was very thin and in poor condition,



and a decision was made to euthanize the animal. Sadly, a plastic bag was found in his stomach but it was too late to save it.

On Dec. 5, 2015, the annual North Palm Beach Boat Parade occurred along the intracoastal, starting at Peanut Island and ending at Jupiter lighthouse.
