

Pool Rules

Pool Hours - Dawn to dusk

- 1. There is NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY. Swimming is at your own risk. Be safe.
 - a. No diving.
 - b. All children must be accompanied by an adult.
- 2. Be considerate of others:
 - a. No loud music. Always use headphones.
 - b. No smoking of any kind in the pool or patio area.
 - c. No splashing.
 - d. Only toilet-trained children are permitted in the pool. No diapers of any kind.
 - e. No large recreational toys permitted in the pool, e.g., body float boards, air mattresses, or other inflatables.
- 3. No running or horseplay around the pool.
- 4. Emergency pool equipment ring, hook, and rope may only be used for emergencies.
- 5. NO GLASS containers or items in the pool area. Plastic items are okay.
- 6. Shower before entering the pool to remove sand and body lotions.
- 7. Pool furniture must not be removed from the pool and patio area or placed on the grassed areas. Place towel on chairs when using sunscreen. Rearrange chairs when leaving and lower umbrellas there is no pool service other than you to keep the pool area safe and attractive.
- 8. Pets must be carried or on a leash on their way to the beach. No pets are permitted to linger in the pool or patio area.
- 9. Dry off before entering the lobby to prevent the floor from becoming slippery.
